


Figure 2: Current housing stock of the Town.




Figure 1: Town of Midland.

As per the County's Residential Land Budget 2019 the Town has a demand for approximately 2,150 units to accommodate the 2031 forecasted population. This would require the Town to add about 179 new units/year to meet this forecast. The Town is currently building out at about 29% of that rate (Table 2).
