



# Curbside Collection Reminders



Residents **MUST** have garbage & recyclables to the curb by **7:00 a.m.** on their collection day. Call **705.735.6901** or **1.800.263.3199** to find out your collection day.

## 2-BAG LIMIT



Maximum of two bags/containers per week. Additional bags/containers must have a "Garbage Tag" affixed. Tags are \$2.00 each and are sold in sheets of 5.

**Exceptions:** There is a 1-bag limit in **Adjala-Tosorontio** and garbage tags are not permitted. In **Penetanguishene**, **ALL BAGS** must be tagged.

## GARBAGE CONTAINER SIZE & WEIGHT LIMITS

Please adhere to the following limits:

### BAGS

- Maximum weight 20 kg (44 lbs)
- A standard bag size 90 cm x 75 cm (36" x 30") is acceptable
- No loose grocery/kitchen catcher bags (place these inside a garbage bag or can)

### CANS

- Maximum weight 20 kg (44 lbs)
- Maximum can size is 77 litres (17 gallons)
- Must have a secure fitting lid
- No tie downs or bungee cords permitted
- Oversized containers: Place properly secured garbage bag(s) inside - remember that Garbage Tags are required for all bags over the limit of two (2).

# Garbage Container Size

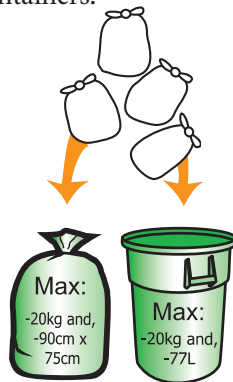
The County of Simcoe notes that County-wide our collection contractors have been encountering increasing difficulties, at some locations, with oversized and over-weight containers. The County's container size and weight restrictions have not changed with the implementation of the standardized two bag limit. The difficulty with oversized cans is that due to the can's size it is easy to exceed the limits for:

- volume max. 77L (17 gallons) **and/or**
- weight max 20 kg (44 lbs)

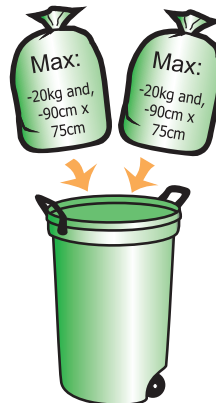
To ensure collection we recommend either:

1. Deposit loose garbage into standard sized containers.
2. Place a maximum of 2 standard sized bags into your oversized bin.

For additional waste, please purchase bag tags.

**Exceptions:**  
Adjala-Tosorontio: Max. 1 bag limit (no tags)  
Penetanguishene: All bags must be tagged.

## How to Use Garbage Tags

For waste over the 2 bag limit, please affix a garbage tag to each additional bag/can. Tags are strictly for household garbage and not for yard waste or bulky items.



- Place Garbage Tag around the neck of garbage bags.
- Place the Tag on the upper most article inside the can, **NOT ON THE CAN ITSELF.**
