in the past few years, pointing out the great demand for them and the liberal grants made by the Local Legislature to encourage them for the benefit of suffering humanity. The great number of Patients treated in Hospital successfully was a strong argument in their favor. Nearly every Municipality in the County had sent Patients to the Royal Victoria Hospital and on account of this growing demand for Admittance of Patients the Board were compelled to build in order to cope with the number seeking treatment. The cost of the new building would be about \$12,000. The board would therefore ask the County to contribute about 2,000 as their share of building the Hospital.

H. H. Strath <sup>Spokes</sup> H. C. The next to address the Council Alluding in a very feeling manner the good work done at the Hospital, which the speaker said was for the poor and needy as well as for the rich, no matter what disease they were suffering from, a more Christian and humane Institution could not be recognized by the Council. And a more fitting Memorial could not be erected to our late good Sovereign Her Majesty Queen Victoria. Sheriff Murray the next speaker said that he was a convert to the maintenance and erection of good Hospitals after seeing the noble and Christian work done at the Barris Hospital, he felt like doing all in his power to make them a benefit for the community at large. Requesting the Council to make a liberal grant which he was sure would be sanctioned by the Ratepayers.
