His Worship the Warden in addressing the Council said it was his sad duty to inform the Council of the decease of one of its members since the last meeting of the Council in the person of James Joyce, Deputy Reeve of the Township of Ouellet, a man of sterling worth, a man who was highly appreciated by the members of this Council and the Municipality wherein he resided. He stated that the Patriotic Association were requesting this Council to continue the grant to that Association for the year 1918 on a similar basis as that given during 1917 namely \$1000 per month. He spoke strongly of the great work that is being done by the Patriotic Society and the necessity of continuing assistance to them. He also stated there would be an application for assistance from the British Sailors Relief Association. He welcomed Mr. J. B. Johnston, Reeve of the Town of Ouellet to this Council Board, Mr. Johnston having been elected to fill the term of Duncan McNeil, deceased. He requested the Council to be as economical as possible with efficiency
