## Local Immigration Partnership: Human Services Sub-Council Work Plan

Local Immigration Partnerships (LIPs) support the development of local partnerships and community-based planning that support successful outcomes for newcomers. A settlement Strategy is built on the principles of **attraction**, **recruitment**, **integration**, **and retention**.

The Simcoe County Local Immigration Partnership launched the Community Settlement Strategy on November 17, 2012, following a yearlong community research process. The research identified issues and barriers impeding immigrants' success. Four themes emerged from the research, which provide a blueprint for establishing Simcoe County as a welcoming community:

**Readiness:** Strengthen basic public services to promote retention **Opportunity:** Promote employment and business opportunities

**Celebrate:** Demonstrate a supportive environment and celebrate diversity **Inspire:** Empower newcomers to contribute to local leadership capacity
