Trillium Manor Enteric Outbreak Update

Dear Family and Friends,

As of November 19th, 2021, the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit has placed the Ramara Unit under Enteric Outbreak. Currently, we have three (3) residents that are experiencing gastro-enteric symptoms and we are closely monitoring all residents on this unit and throughout the home. Until further notice the following protocols will be in place:

VISITING REQUIREMENTS:

All general visitors' appointments have been cancelled to the Home. Essential Caregivers may continue to visit their loved ones in the home however, we are also asking these individuals to consider pausing visits temporarily to help us reduce the risk of spread by reducing the traffic levels in the home.

OUTBREAK PRECAUTIONS:

We continue with the following outbreak precautions on all units:

- Alterations in table arrangements have been made to ensure physician distancing
- All **symptomatic** residents receive:
 - Contact droplet isolation precautions
 - Quarantine with tray service for all meals
- Strict staff cohorting is in place
- Additional cleaning is in place
- One to one programming – group programs are on hold
- Essential caregivers are permitted
- General visits are cancelled to the impacted unit

As the cold and flu season is now upon us, we remind those entering our home to please remember to **follow all enhanced PPE and hand hygiene practices** when both in our home or out in the community.

We will keep you updated on the status of test results. Thank you for your ongoing support.
