

Update 5.0 – 06 January 2021

COVID-19 Update at Georgian Manor

Dear Family and Friends,

We are very pleased to report that our numbers remain stable. Georgian Manor has not had any additional cases since Friday, January 1, and all cases remain isolated to two (2) resident units. We continue with two (2) active resident cases and three (3) active staff cases in total.

We continue to work closely with our partners in Public Health to manage this outbreak. And together, we are implementing procedures to prevent transmission and keep staff and residents safe.

We know that this is a challenging time for our families. Please know that we are doing everything possible to control this outbreak and keep our residents safe. While visitation to our facilities is restricted by the provincial lockdown, families continue to care for our residents by reducing their own risk of contracting and spreading COVID-19 in our communities. When going out into the community for essential reasons only, please remember to be COVID-WISE:

- W – Wear a mask or face covering where required, or when you cannot maintain a physical distance of two metres (six feet)
- I – Isolate yourself from others when you are sick (and get tested if you have COVID-like symptoms)
- S – Stay at least two metres (six feet) apart from those outside your household
- E – Exercise proper hand hygiene; wash your hands regularly or use sanitizer especially before touching your face

By working together, we will reduce community transmission and cut our infection rates. The sooner we curb community spread, the sooner these long-term care outbreaks end. We thank you for your support and cooperation.
