POTENTIAL CANADA POST WORK STOPPAGE

HOW THIS WILL AFFECT ONTARIO WORKS PARTICIPANTS

The County of Simcoe has taken steps to assist individuals and families who rely on Ontario Works for income and employment support to continue to receive the best possible service during the potential Canada Post work stoppage.

- Please review to this important message about how your Ontario Works payments will be affected by the potential Canada Post work stoppage
- **Effective Thursday September 20th, mail (including cheques) will not be sent to Canada Post for delivery.**
- The deposit date of Direct Bank Deposits will not be affected
- Direct bank deposit statements, income statements and client letters will be mailed once standard operations resume.
- It is your responsibility to report all income and any changes in your circumstances, if you require any forms they will be available for pick up and drop off at your local Ontario Works office. Commonly requested forms can also be found on our website: <http://www.simcoe.ca>
- Cheques will be available for pick up daily at the local Ontario Works offices, identification will be required, pick up times are as follows:
 - Alliston 3:00 to 4:30pm
 - Barrie 2:00 to 4:30pm
 - Collingwood 3:00 to 4.30pm
 - Midhurst 3:00 to 4.30pm
 - Midland 2:00 to 4:30pm
 - Orillia 2:00 to 4:30pm
