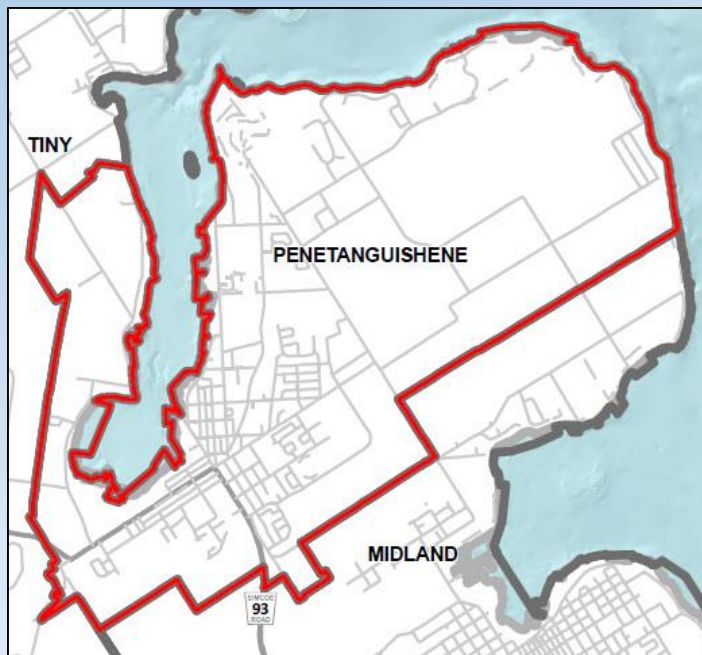


Figure 1: Town of Penetanguishene.

In terms of residential units, the population difference relative to the Growth Plan forecast translates to approximately 831 units. This would require the Town to add about 55 new units/year to meet this forecast. The Town is currently building out at about 70% of that rate (Table 2).

Occupied Private Dwellings by Period of Construction

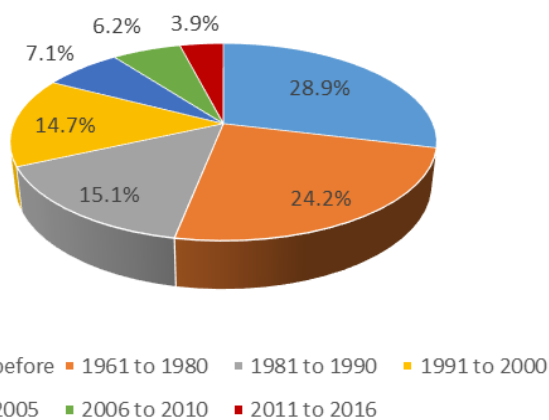


Figure 2: Current housing stock of the Town.
