By dividing the Rural Unit Supply figure of 2,257 from the 2017 Land Budget by the average uptake of Rural lots (see Table above), the Township has an approximate 47 year supply of Rural units.

Occupied Private Dwellings by Period of Construction

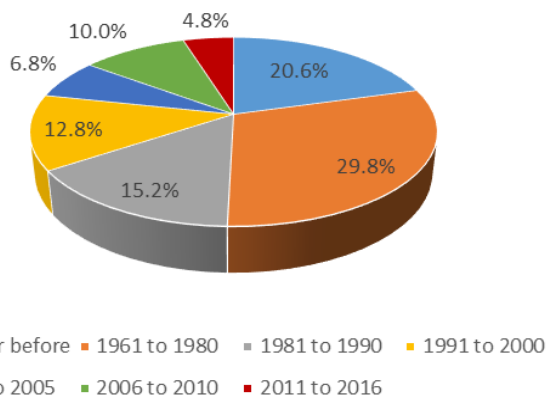


Figure 2: Current housing stock of the Township.

Over the period of 2011-2016 the Administrative and Support, Waste Management and Remediation Services Industry saw the most growth, adding approximately 110 new jobs.

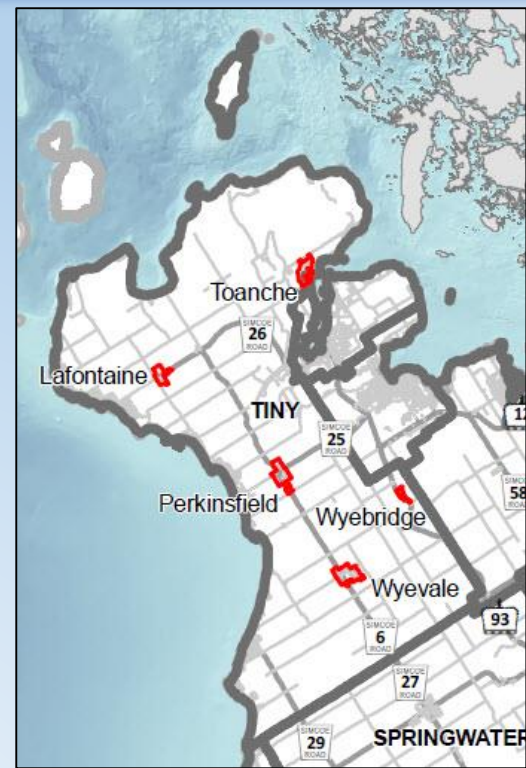


Figure 1: Settlement areas in the Township of Tiny.

In terms of residential units, the population difference relative to the Growth Plan forecast translates to approximately 699 units. This would require the Township to add approximately 47 units/year to meet this forecast. The Township is currently building out at about 113% of the required rate needed.
