Notes: The intensification target for the Town in s. 3.5.24 of the County of Simcoe Official Plan is 40%. The 2031 population forecast for the Town is 50,500 persons as per County of Simcoe Official Plan.

By dividing the Rural Unit Supply figure of 720 from the 2019 Land Budget by the average uptake of Rural lots (see Table above), the Town has an approximate 83 year supply of Rural units.

Occupied Private Dwellings by Period of Construction

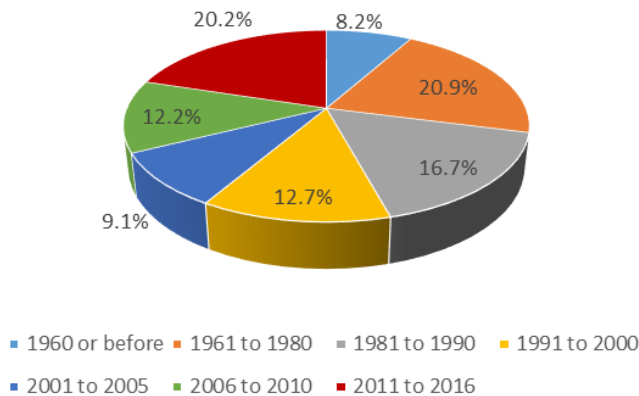


Figure 2: Current housing stock of the Town.

Over the period of 2011-2016 the Construction Industry in Bradford West Gwillimbury saw the most growth, adding 965 new jobs.

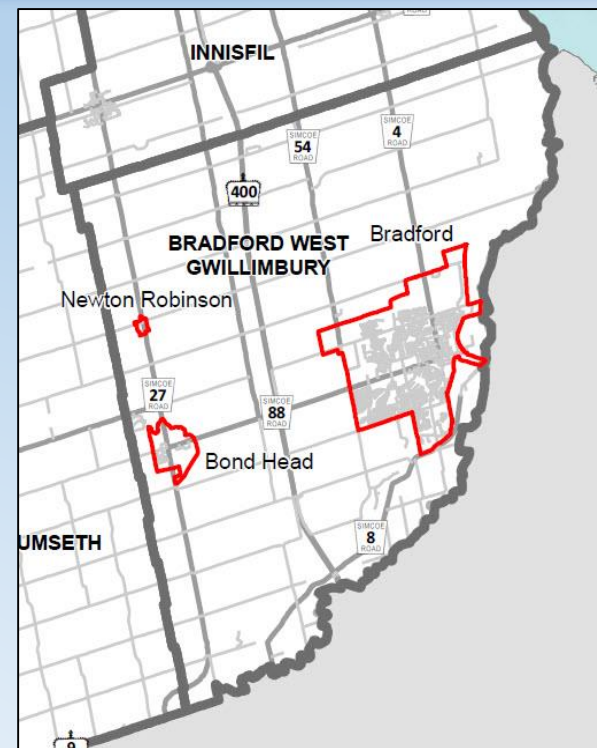


Figure 1: Settlement areas in the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury.

As per the County's Residential Land Budget 2019 the Town has a demand for approximately 4,680 units to accommodate the 2031 forecasted population. This would require the Town to add about 390 new units/year to meet this forecast. The Town is currently building out at about 98% of that rate (Table 2).
