By dividing the Rural Unit Supply figure of 285 from the 2019 Land Budget by the average uptake of Rural lots (see Table above), the Township has an approximate 15.5 year supply of Rural units.




Figure 2: Current housing stock of the Township.

Over the period of 2011-2016 the Healthcare and Social Assistance Industry saw the most growth, adding approximately 270 new jobs.




Figure 1: Settlement areas in the Township of Ramara.

As per the County's Residential Land Budget 2019 the Township has a demand for approximately 1,460 units to accommodate the 2031 forecasted population. This would require the Township to add about 122 new units/year to meet this forecast. The Township is currently building out at about 31% of that rate (Table 2).
