County Road 27 and Line 5 Intersection Improvements

**County Road 27 and Line 5
Intersection Improvements**

The construction work along County Road 27 and Line 5 is scheduled to recommence starting April 11, 2022. Work remaining to be completed includes full reconstruction of Line 5, both east and west of County Road 27, including installation of storm sewers, road profile adjustments, curbs, paving, guide rail and restoration as well as installation of traffic signals at the intersection and restoration works along County Road 27.

In order to permit installation of the storm sewers along Line 5, Line 5 west of County Road 27 is scheduled to be closed from April 11 to May 1, while Line 5 east of County Road 27 is scheduled to be closed from May 2 to May 18. Separate road closure notices will be provided to the local residents, emergency services, waste collection, school transportation consortium and Canada Post prior to the road closures.

How Will I Get to My Home/Business?

The contractor is required to maintain access to all homes and businesses throughout construction. However, there will be occasions where access to driveways may be interrupted for a period of 24 to 48 hours to facilitate road and storm sewer works as well as for actual driveway reconstruction. On these occasions, advanced notice will be provided to the affected property owners along with alternate arrangements for overnight parking. Every effort will be made to limit the duration of these interruptions and to restore driveway access as quickly as possible.

Regardless, pedestrian access will be maintained to homes and businesses all times during construction.

If you have any special needs or require wheelchair access to your property, please advise the Ainley Group Construction Inspector.

Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, electrical, cable TV and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Safety

Construction involves the use of heavy equipment and the unavoidable creation of obstacles.

These circumstances are often attractive to children, and as such, we ask that you caution your children to stay clear of the working area.

While the contractor is required to conduct the work in a safe manner, we ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.
