PARAMEDIC FOR A DAY



On Tuesday, May 28, 2019, County of Simcoe Paramedic Services will award one lucky student from an elementary school in Simcoe County the title of Paramedic for a Day

What is Paramedic for a Day?

- One lucky student will be chosen from a school in Simcoe County to spend the day on the job with local Paramedics. The student will be picked up from school by a paramedic crew in the ambulance before being sworn in as an Honorary Junior Paramedic. The student will also participate in various tours and activities throughout the day.

Who is eligible to enter for a chance to win?

- Submissions are open to Grade 5 and 6 students.

How does your student participate?

- A student interested in participating must prepare a short video (maximum two minutes) detailing why they want to be a Paramedic for a Day and what Paramedic Services means to them. Explain in the video why the role of a paramedic is so important to the community. The winner will be chosen based on their video entry.
- Deadline for video submission is May 16, 2019 at 5 p.m.
- All entries become property of the County of Simcoe Paramedic Services.
- The student's photograph will be taken during the event. Photographs may be used, re-used, published and republished in whole or in part, individually or in conjunction with other individuals' images for purposes of promotion, advertising or journalism in any medium, including, but not limited to, printed materials, staff brochures/communications, photographic displays, video footage, media reports, published on the County of Simcoe's corporate website, intranet and digital panels.
- The winning student's parent/guardian and teacher must permit the student to be away from school on May 28, 2019 in the care and supervision of the staff from Simcoe County Paramedic Services.
