

Memorandum June 19th 1863

The Council met this day pursuant to a summons from the Clerk, in consequence of a Writ issued by the Sheriff Justice of the Court of Common Pleas, commanding him to hold an election in accordance with the Statute in the Province of electing a Warden for the Corporation of the County of Dineen, in the term and state of Thomas R Ferguson Esq who had been removed from the said office.
