 Ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to send By registers
 Same Post together with the copy of the By-Law to designate
 Highways required to be transmitted to the Clerks of the
 Townships of the County under the Act for the improvement
 of Public Highways a map or plan of the County
 showing the designated Highways which he is hereby
 authorized to procure and prepare, and a notice in the
 words or to the effect following
