His Honor Judge Vance then held special Court to administer the oath of Office to the Warden Elect.

The Warden then took the Chair.

At the request of the Council his Honor Judge Vance invited the Ministerial Association of the Town of Barrie to open the Session with devotional services when the Rev. G. A. Benson M. A. gave a short address and the Rev. S. M. Beach offered prayer.

His Honor Judge Vance in his address stated that he hoped soon to see the ladies present and would like to see them attend these ceremonies as they would soon have the franchise the same as men and their names would be on this year's votes lists.

The Ladies at the present moment were attending the opening of the last session of the present Legislature in Toronto and their presence adds to the betterment of Legislation.

He was glad to see the Ministerial Association present and open the proceedings of the Council for this year. It is the experience and history of all nations that they did not long exist who did not put first things first.

He stated that he had an admiration for all County Councils and especially this County Council. He admired men who offered their services to the state and in his opinion a good municipal contest was good for every Municipality as it acquainted the ratepayers with the business of their Councils.

He referred feelingly to the absence from the Clerk's desk of the familiar face of the late Clerk Mr. R. J. Lelake and mentioned his worth as an efficient official and his sterling qualities as a public spirited citizen.

That all Non-resident Auctioneers be charged the sum of \$40.00 for their license in order to protect resident Auctioneers of the County of Simcoe and that the By Law be amended accordingly.

Mr J. B. Johnston M.P.P. for East Simcoe whom the Warden bared to take a seat beside him on the dais addressed the Council and congratulated the Warden

on his election to the position of Warden of the County, he being the first from the eastern part of the County to fill the Wardens Chair and of the of road construction and road expenditures.

Moved by Councillor Robertson and seconded by Councillor Patterson and ordered.

That the Council go into Committee of the whole for permit Mr. Wilson, Auditor, to explain plans re improvements to Registry Office with Councillor G. Wilson Chairman of the County Property Committee in the chair.
