Council held Barrie June 21/1875
The Council met this evening pursuant to adjournment
from the January Session,
The Warden in the Chair
Present all members except Messrs Small, Curmishers
Kegan, Fitzgualdo and Booth.
The minutes of last day of January Session were read
and confirmed

E. B. Saunders Esq filed his Certificate and took
his seat as Reeve of Stagers Vice Randolph resigned
The Warden addressed the Council on the various
subject affecting the interests of the County since the
last Session.

The Warden presented the following documents which
which were read viz: Communications from the President
and Secretary of the Simcoe and Huron and Ontario
Ship Canal Company, of the President and Secretary
of the North Simcoe Railway Company and Reports
No. 1 and 2 of the County Surveyor.
