And whereas this Council are representatives of a large and fertile Agricultural County we consider it to be our duty to protest against anything which will be a detriment or discouraging to stock raising and that a special Committee composed of Messrs Ross (or) Jeffs, Dilligan, Lawson, Fisher, Brothers Roman, Martin, and the mover and seconder be appointed to draft a Memorial to the Minister of Agriculture protesting against any change of Tariff which will interfere with the advancement of the stock raising industry in the Dominion and that the Clerk be requested to forward the Memorial duly signed and sealed to the Minister of Agriculture.
