This Council desires at this its first-session since  
 the sad event to place on record its sense of the  
 deep loss sustained by the removal of one whom  
 every Member could safely call a friend, and to  
 bear witness to his integrity, zeal, and energy in the  
 discharge of his duties.

That removal cannot be called an untimely one,  
 as our old friend passed away full of years as well  
 as honor, having more than fulfilled his allotted  
 three score years and ten.

Year after year such succeeding Councils without  
 hesitation called upon him to fill the honored position  
 of Clerk, knowing that he could at all times be called  
 upon by any Member for that advice and counsel, which  
 his many years of experience well qualified him to give.  
 When it is remembered that for upwards of half a century  
 his own Township has claimed his services as Clerk  
 of its local Council, it will be seen in what high estimation  
 he was held by those who knew him best and among  
 whom he spent the greater part of his long life.

A man of upright and unblameable life and of  
 courteous and obliging manners, he lived honored and  
 respected by all who knew him, not only in his own

neighborhood, but indeed everywhere throughout, and  
 often outside the County at large.

It is well known by those in Authority who had the  
 supervision of his official duties, he was most highly  
 thought of, and his judgment respected in the faithful  
 performance of those duties testifying to his strict integrity
