The Clerk declared no election, The Clerk then proceeded to take a third nomination allowing 15 minutes as above for Mr. Murphy Campbell, Leachy, Graham Harvie Hammill Leathersdale, Murphy, Sloane, Wright - 9 for Mr. Bruce, Bruce, Emerson, Fraser, Jupp, Martin, Strawley, Thorpe, Whitesides, Wells - 9 The same Candidates were again nominated and the vote

again resulted in a tie, The Clerk declared no election

On Motion of Mr Jupp seconded by Mr. Graham and ordered That this Council do now adjourn until 10 O'clock tomorrow morning
