had their names withdrawn from the nomination

After waiting 15 minutes the Clerk declared the nominations closed

and proceeded to take the vote when William Wood, Reev. of West-Quillimbury
received a majority vote of the Council and the Clerk declared him duly
elected Warden of the County of Simcoe for the year 1914.

His Honour Judge Vance held a Special Court and administered
the oath of office to the Warden elect
The Warden then took the chair,

His Honour Judge Vance addressed the Council in his usual fluent
manner expressing it a pleasure in addressing so large and influential
a body as the Council of the County of Simcoe a body who he had no doubt
would administer the affairs of the County in an economical and business
like manner, He praised the Municipal Laws of the Province and stated
where these laws were complied with general satisfaction was given and
he was glad to say that so far as the Municipal Councils of the Townships
Towns and Villages were concerned the laws were loyally adhered to
but he was afraid he could not say so with regard to the Cities
He referred to the high cost of living and claimed that the rate payers
especially the farmers who could now practically obtain twice the
value for their products to what they obtained 20 years ago should not
object to an increase in the taxes which evidently cannot be
avoided through prices having been raised,

were not in as good a position as they were some years ago not
due to the necessary heavy expenditure on Bridges caused through
the recent floods, He did not expect to fill the office of Warden with such
great ability as some of his predecessors he being only a plain farmer
but that he would do his best and would always endeavour to do credit
to the confidence placed in him by his fellow members,
