The Council met pursuant to adjournment from the June Session

His Worship the Warden in addressing the Council said it was his sad duty to inform the Council of the decease of one of its members since the last meeting of the Council in the person of James Joyce, Deputy Reeve of the Township of Ouellet, a man of sterling worth, a man who was highly appreciated by the members of this Council and the Municipality wherein he resided. He stated that the Patriotic Association were requesting this Council to continue the grant to that Association for the year 1918 on a similar basis as that given during 1917 namely \$1,000.00 per month. He spoke strongly of the great work that is being done by the Patriotic Society and the necessity of continuing assistance to them. He also stated there would be an application for assistance from the British Sailors Relief Association. He welcomed Mr. J. B. Johnston, Reeve of the town of Ouellet to this Council Board, Mr. Johnston having been elected to fill the term of Duncan Mc Nab, deceased. He requested the Council to be as economical as possible with efficiency

And we would further strongly urge upon the people of this County to put forth their strongest and mightiest effort to produce and conserve foodstuffs so that not only the brave boys of Canada who are fighting our battles may be fed but also all other Countries who are in sympathy with the allies may have sufficient food to allow them to give all the help possible in winning the war
